EXPERIENCE

After site experience with Monk and Wilson Lovatt during his sandwich course at college he commenced work with M & H Tunnel in 1969 as Site Engineer responsible for setting out on numerous contracts throughout England.

From 1972 until 1977 he was employed by W A Dawson as Site Engineer and then Sub-Agent on contracts including – Dovercourt Cliff stabilisation, Dewsbury Flood Alleviation, Fleetwood Harbour and Lee Valley Flood Alleviation.

Between 1977 and 1979 he worked for May Gurney, Colchester as Sub-Agent on contracts throughout the South East, including flood prevention for GEGB Thames Area, Lymington Marina, Footbridge A127, Dockyard piling Brightlingsea, timber groynes at Southend, storm damage repairs at Clacton and Walton Piers

From 1979 until 1982 he was General Works Contracts Manager for Tilbury Construction at Erith and subsequently at the Wakefield office undertook many small to medium size contracts in the South East and North East regions.

From 1982 until the company was effectively taken over by Stent Foundations in 1990 he was Contracts Manager/Operations Director for the piling division of 3M Civil Engineering having responsibility for all aspects of the running of sub-contract piling throughout the UK.

After Stent acquired the 3M operation, as Contracts Manager he developed and ran the Sheet Piling Department until 1998.
